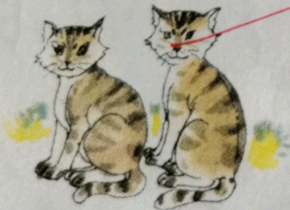

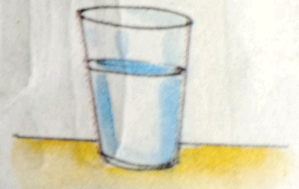

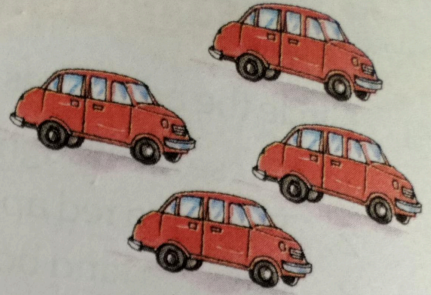

Mary's house has a red roof. It has yellow walls. The door is blue. The car is black. The tree is green. Mary is wearing an orange dress.





The children played outside. The children sat inside. The balloon went up. The words **here, there, above, outside, inside** and **up** add something to the meaning of the verbs **sits, stands, sky, played, sat** and **went**. They tell us where the action is done. Such words are also called **Adverbs**.

**Now read these sentences :**

1. Jatin goes to school **early**.
2. Father comes home **late**.
3. Ashwani came **yesterday**.
4. Shalu will come **tomorrow**.
5. I shall return **soon**.
6. Do it **now**.

The words **early, late, yesterday, tomorrow, soon** and **now** add something to the meaning of the verbs **goes, comes, came, will come, shall return** and **do**. They tell us **when** the action is done. Such words are also called **Adverbs**.

Words which add something to the meaning of verbs, and tell us **how** an action is done, **where** it is done or **when** it is done, are called **Adverbs**.
